#### 1. Workshop for Under Graduate Architecture Students in Third Year



A "Workshop on Earthquake Resistant Practices for Undergraduate Students of Architecture" was conducted at IIT Kanpur during June 17 – 23, 2018, as a part of NICEE initiative towards reaching the architects of tomorrow

through a hands-on programme in earthquake resistant architectural design. The workshop will be attended by 61 participants of 16 colleges from all over India. The aim of this workshop was to sensitize the students of architecture in earthquake resistant design practices through technical lectures followed by design studios where they were given guidance in earthquake resistant design by working on an architectural design project.

During the seven-day workshop the students were asked to design an Office Complex in a site in Gandhidham, a city in Kutch district, Gujarat, located in Seismic Zone V. Students were exposed to RESIST software to test the adequacy of their designs from seismic performance perspective and this session helped them to arrive at reasonable sizes of structural members.
